Fire Hydrant Flushing in Cumberland, Dauphin, Perry and York County service areas

United Water will flush fire hydrants in the counties listed above from April 2 through mid-June. Flushing removes harmless minerals that collect in the water mains. The project is part of the company's routine maintenance program to assure high water quality. Flushing also ensures that the hydrants are working properly and are available for emergency purposes.

Some customers may experience low water pressure or discolored water during the flushing process. This situation is temporary. We recommend that you wait until it runs clear before drinking or washing clothes or dishes. We apologize for this inconvenience as we work to serve you better.
